AACA General Meeting Minutes

May 22, 2019

President Carolyn Freeman opened the meeting at 7:12 p.m. and introduced the board members, Jacques Romain, Vice President; Diane Ditzler, Secretary; Diane Tuluceanu, Treasurer; Mike Bang, Member-At-Large.
